Use the following formula to make sure your netting is evenly spaced on the lifeline and hangs correctly.

## For:

- 18" high lifelines, count 14 meshes (diamonds) for every 4' of lifeline 24" high lifelines, count 16 meshes (diamonds) for every 4' of lifeline
- 30" high lifelines, count 15 meshes (diamonds) for every 4' of lifeline 36" high lifelines, count 17 meshes (diamonds) for every 4' of lifeline
- Count out the meshes and tack them in place with white cable ties.
- To secure the top edge of the netting, either weave your lifeline cable through the meshes or lace the meshes to the lifeline by wrapping them in place with nylon twine.
- To secure the bottom edge of the netting, tie the  $\frac{1}{4}$ " polyester rope off at the stanchion near the bow, then weave the rope through the meshes along the deck, tying off at every stanchion with two or more overhand knots.
- When you are done, you can also tack the netting in place along the top and bottom every foot or so using white cable ties.
